Online-Registration

until 30 June (application for the Winter semester) or until 15 January (application for the Summer semester).

Documents you need:

- Language Certificate for the language of tuition (usually B1 or B2 CEFR -> Ask the International Office at your home institution for the required language level.) (Form provided at www.uni-leipzig.de/en/erasmus/in.)
- Confirmation of your nomination by your home university (Nomination letter)

Application for Language and Orientation Course

(minimum German onlevel B1/B2) as part of the online registration

What is the Language and Orientation course?

- three weeks just before the start of the new semester and classes
- limited number of places: participation is allocated based on the date of receipt of the complete online application (first come, first served)
- participation fee: 105€
- confirmation whether you may participate in the course will be sent together with your letter of admission in August or February
- if you successfully sit the final test you will receive a certificate and 3 credits
